Missouri Junior Limousin Association Scholarship

Eligibility

Any active senior in high school member of the Missouri Junior Limousin Association (MJLA) attending any institution of higher education (2 year and 4-year colleges) is eligible to apply.

Funds

MJLA will pay its scholarship directly to the recipient.

Selection

The candidates will be based on the recipient's excellence; demonstrated leadership; citizenship; financial need; and participation in 4-H, FFA and Limousin junior activities. The scholarship form must be postmarked by March 31, and the recipient will be announced at the MLBA banquet. The winner does not need to be present to receive the award.

Application Procedure

2. Complete the application in detail, a recent photo of yourself and 2 letters of recommendation—to the following address by March 22nd.
3. Failure to include all the required information will disqualify the applicant automatically.
